ABC	To begin a sentence and for names and places.
!	For exclamations or surprises.
?	For questions.
,	Comma to separate items in a list: sheep, cows, pigs, dogs

Noun	A person, place, animal or thing.
Adjective	Describes a noun.
Verb	A doing or being word.
Adverb	Describes a verb.
