
Writing tricky words

The expectation is that this term, the children should be able to read the Phase 2 and Phase 3 tricky words and be able to write those in Phase 2 (but we do practise writing the phase 3 words too).

I have also included a worksheet for more practise if you wish, but you might need to have a break if you've worked through the song too. Otherwise, you may have tricky word overload!



Number

We are continuing with adding this week but without the spiders! We will be using the Numicon tiles for most of the activities.



Just a reminder that when we are adding, we are are putting two groups of objects together and then counting them all to find the total or how many there are altogether. We use the words **add** and **total**.

When we are using the Numicon tiles, it is exactly the same, but we will be choosing 2 Numicon tiles and counting all of the holes to find the total.

Today, the children need to choose 2 Numicon tiles and then place them onto the 'Can you make your own Numicon number sentence?' sheet.




