



Good morning!

We are going to try 2 new sounds today, **V** and **W**.

You can watch the video and then have a go at reading the words on the sheet.

Included is a colour by **j v w** word superhero to practise reading the words too. Don't forget to do your very best colouring and pinch your pen or pencil whether you are writing, colouring or drawing!



You can have a go at writing the words on the sheet too.

Use your fingers to help you to hear all 3 sounds. Don't worry if you can only hear the first sound on your own. Write that down.



I am sending the sound mats to help you.

We have started on the second side so you will find **j, v, w** at the top.

Parents, we are starting in phase 3 of letters and sounds which are the sounds on the second side of the mat. Some children are still getting to grips with Phase 2 and that is fine. If they are finding the new sounds tricky, look at the ones that we covered last term. Can your child remember them all? Can they write them down when you ask?

On Cbeebies iPlayer there is an Alphablocks video called 'van' which practises **j** and **v**

The book 'Van' to go with this is on Phonics Bug for you to read.
