WALT: use expanded noun phrases.

In year 2, the children need to be able to use expanded noun phrases. This means using adjectives (describing words) with a noun (name words). For example: The **big, red flames** shot up into the air. The words, **big** and **red** are **adjectives** because they are describing the **flames**, which is the **noun**.

Make a cool hot air balloon

You will need:

Bowl Balloon Spoon Glue
