
Letters and Sounds

Today we are going to write some of the **oo** words that we read yesterday with the short **oo** sound (look at a book).

After reading through the words again, use the sheet 'Look at the wool'.

The children need to start by writing the word **look**, then change one of the letters each time to make the next word until you get to **wool**. The words are:


- look
- book
- hook
- hood
- good
- wood
- wool



Ask your child to sound out, then write **look** **l-oo-k**. Then say 'for the next word, we are going to change the **l** to a **b**. What's the new word?' then write it in the box.

As an extra activity, if you have some Cheerios at home, you could try using them to make oo words! Just for fun!


Please don't buy some just for the activity. You could just write them instead.



Number

We are going to use the Numicon pegs with the tiles today to complete the PJ Mask subtraction number sentences.

You can print the number sentences or you could just write them on a piece of paper instead.



So, $9 - 3 =$



9 is the starting number so find the 9 tile and put a peg into each hole.

(This is also good practise for fine motor control and making fingers strong.)



You now need to subtract/take 3 pegs away and count how many are left.


The bottom 4 on the sheet are again more challenging as you need to make the teen number with the tiles.

Expressive Art and Design
