

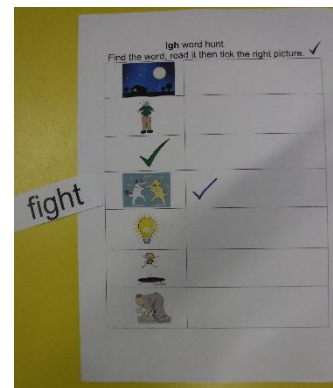

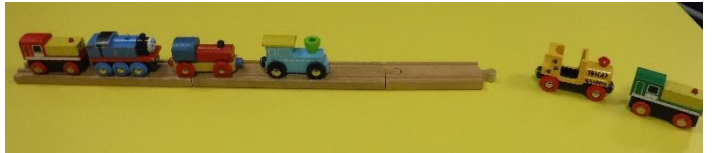

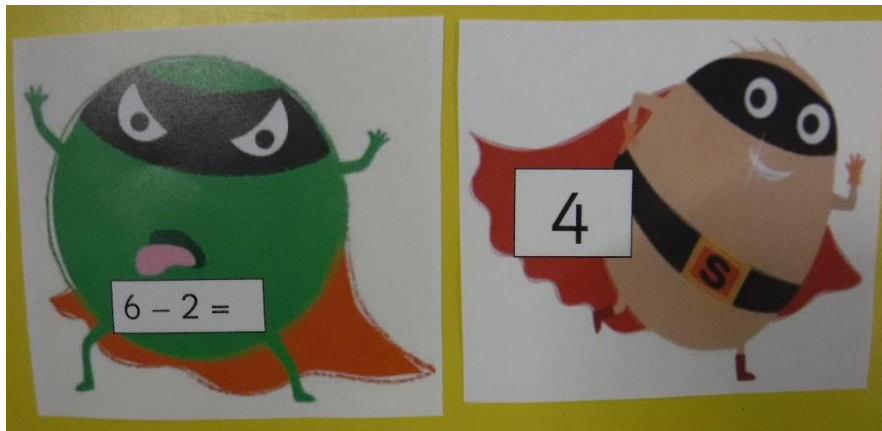
Today there are some Evil Pea subtraction number sentences and the Supertato matching answers.
