Letters and Sounds

Good morning!

Today there are three new tricky words to introduce **my**, **was** and **you**. I have added them to the previous Phase 3 tricky words.

Read them together, remember that you can't use your sounds, that's why they are tricky, but the first sound will give a big clue. I will often use my sounds to read them initially to show that it doesn't work. It may take a while to remember them.

There is a tricky word game to play below too.

Tricky word trucks





You can choose the tricky words to practise.

If you press **Start**, then **Pick individual tricky words**.

Choose - All Phase 2 plus Phase 3 **he**, **she**, **me**, **we**, **be**, **was**, **you**, **my**.

There are also some sentences to read and to spot and colour the tricky words.




Can you remember which the new tricky words are?

Number

In number, we are continuing with subtraction this week, but using the Numicon tiles.

We are going to subtract by taking away (crossing out) holes in the Numicon tiles. The children have done this before when we were finding 1 less, so they might remember.




$$7 - 2 =$$

So, 7 take away 2 equals...

The starting number is 7, we need to take 2 away (subtract 2) and then count how many holes are left.

We are taking holes away by crossing them out.



On the second sheet, you can choose how many you would like to take away and then complete the number sentence.

There is a black and white version included if you prefer, for those printing at home.
