WALT: use multiplication to solve number sentences.

Do you remember that multiplication is the same as repeated addition? So,  $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$  is the same as  $3 \times 4 = 12$  because the  $\times$  symbol means 'lots of'. So 3 lots of 4 = 12. Solve the multiplications below.
