Times tables & spelling

Have a go at your weekly times table sheet.

Test this week's spellings then have a look at the next week's spellings. Practise them using LCWC, use them in a sentence, practise saying them out loud and look any word meanings you do not know.

English

WALT: Write our own animal poem.

Today I would like you to pull together all your poetry skills you have practised this week to write your own poem about an animal of your choice. Look at a picture of your animal and think about: how it moves, what sounds does it make, what would it's skin/fur feel like, where does it live. Pick out a few parts of your animal to describe such as the eyes or scales. Look at a picture of your animal closely.

You can make it as long as you like, but I would like at least 5 lines. Remember in poetry, we do not need to write in full sentences or use usual punctuation. Have a read through the poems included in this week's pack to help you think of ideas.

In your poem I would like you to include at least one example of:

- Alliteration
- Onomatopoeia
- Rhyme
- A simile and/ or metaphor
- Adjectives to describe your animal

To help you organise your poem you could use a different feature on each line, or describe a different part of your animal for each line. It is up to you! This is your poem. Read through each line and think about the rhythm of your poem. How would you like it to sound? You could use a mixture of long and short lines.

When you are finished, add a detailed and colourful drawing to your page.

An example from last year:

Roar, hiss and crash,
The lion shakes his huge, hairy head.
As mighty as the sun itself
He stalks his prey while on the prowl,
And others shake when they hear his growl.
