

MARCH 8th ~ FULL RETURN TO SCHOOL...PART 1

IN ORDER TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS WE NEED ALL PARENTS TO...

- Maintain 2m social distancing from other adults and other families. It doesn't matter whether you have been vaccinated or not. Just because your child is friends with a child in their class, as an adult you should still be 2m away from the other parent and their child. The only exception to this is around 'childcare support bubble' or a 'social support bubble'.
Please see Gov.uk info attached.
- Wear a mask when entering school grounds. If you are in a space where people are congregating on the path outside school please put your mask on. If you are exempt from wearing a mask, please ensure you are keeping your distance from others.
- Only one adult for drop off and pick up on the school grounds please. No secondary school siblings, cousins etc.
- Do not arrive at the school gates before 8.45am. We have staff arriving up to 8.45am and need clear access to the gates. People who start queuing at 8.40 or before are not helping the situation. Please time your arrival so you can almost walk straight through the school gates at 8.45am. Keep moving through the side path and into the playground. Say good bye to your child/ren and then follow the one-way system out of school, thank you!
- We would like parents and children just attending main school to arrive from 8.45 to 9am. Please do not be any later than 9 as you will then have to wait as pre-school will be coming in.
- If you are dropping children to both school and pre-school ~ please can you arrive just before 9am. This will ensure you are not hanging around outside pre-school once you have dropped off your main school child waiting for Pre School to open at 9am.
- Pre-school parents need to arrive between 9 and 9.15am and will be entering and exiting by the main gate.
- Pick up for main school will be from 2.55pm to 3.15pm. Again please do not queue at the main gates before 2.55pm, time your arrival so that you can walk straight through after 2.55pm. Please do not hang about in the playground to catch up with other families. If you are bringing a pram/buggy etc then please time your arrival for around 3.10 to 3.15pm as you can then exit via the front gate once the main bulk of parents and children have left. It also means you are not waiting around in the playground or blocking the steps out of the playground stopping the flow of everyone leaving.
 - Those Y6 walking home independently will be released from school at 3.10pm
- If you have urgent messages on a day, please can you email Mrs White in the Office. Any late dinner menus/letters/money etc can be handed to Mrs Mitchelson at the front gate.

We will be monitoring the situation very carefully as the only other option we have is for all children to be dropped off at the gate and straight into school via the red door up the slope and staggered picks up after school which cuts down further on learning time & siblings complications and parents working hours!! If we do have a case in school, then that whole class bubble will need to close including for key worker children and staff.
