Physical Education

English

In Phonics, we will be recapping our Phase 5 sounds and tricky words and learning alternative spellings. We will also be learning to read and write compound words, plurals and suffixes; adding -ed.
We will be practicing our letter formation of capital letters and learning to use these for names of people, places and days of the week. We will also be using !, ? and . in the correct places.
We will be writing our own story about the Queen, as well as looking at non-fiction texts and creating our own fact files.
We will be learning to recite the poem; Pussy Cat Pussy Cat by Spike Milligan.

Computing

We will be using the iPads to create pictures of London Landmarks.
We will be using the internet to find pictures of Queen Elizabeth II throughout her reign and research facts for our non-fiction writing.



History

We will be learning about Queen Elizabeth II's reign, creating a timeline of important events in her lifetime. We will also learn about The Queen's coronation and discuss similarities and differences between life then and today. We will be creating fact files about her life.

Geography

We will be learning about the four countries of the United Kingdom. We will identify these on maps and in atlases. We will identify London landmarks and use geographical vocabulary to refer to physical features in London and compare how these are different to Colchester.

Religious Education

We will be learning about Islam; symbols and objects that are important to us and Muslims. We will also be learning about special days and festivals.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be focussing on the topic of 'Keeping safe', in a familiar and unfamiliar situation; household products; secrets and surprises, appropriate / inappropriate touch.

Science

In Science, we will continue our learning about everyday materials. We will be learning more about where materials come from and how they are made, as well as their properties and suitability for different purposes. We will predict and test our ideas and create products using suitable materials.



Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be recapping doubles and halves to 20, addition and subtraction facts to 20, reading and writing numbers to 100.
We will also introduce fractions to find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shapes and quantities, multiplication, division and telling the time to o'clock and half past.



Art

In Art, we will be looking at the work of Claude Monet, in particular his landscape art. We will be sketching London Landmarks, experimenting with different painting techniques and create our own London Landscape painting in the style of Monet.
